## Dallas Parochial League 13th Annual Coed Soccer Tournament May 13-19, 2013

Tournament is open to all schools that are members of the Dallas Parochial League. Each school may enter 2 coed teams (additional teams if space permits). Players may only play for one team.

Teams must be comprised of **7th and/or 8th grade students only** that are currently enrolled (at the time of the tournament) at that school. Exception: A school may include 7th and 8th grade player(s) from another DPL member school if that school is not fielding a team in this tournament (must have prior approval from the DPL office). Each school is responsible for determining how its teams are to be selected.

Tournament Format will be pool play and the number of pools/games will be decided after the registration process is complete. All games are 11 versus 11 players.

Time limit: All games will be 2 30-minute halves with a 10 minute half time.

Pool play games: If game is tied after regulation, a 5 minute overtime period will be played. Games still tied after the 5 minute overtime will end in a tie.

Play-off games: If game is tied after regulation, a 5 minute overtime period will be played. If still tied, then a shoot-out will result.

Games will be played under North Texas Soccer Association Rules with DPL rules superceding.

Coed teams must have a gender split of 5 and 5 with the goalie being either. Teams will play short if the required number of boys and/or girls is not available. The minimum number of players required to start and finish a game is 7.

When: May 13-19, 2013

Where: University of Texas-Dallas in Richardson, Texas.

Fees: \$375.00 per team

Awards: A Rotating Team Trophy will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup> place team in each division. Medals will be presented to all finalists.

Rosters: It is recommended that each team have a roster size of 16-20 players.

Uniforms: All players must be dressed in matching numbered uniforms. Exception: Goalie must be dressed differently & easily distinguishable as the goalie.
