*United States Swimming guidelines for strokes and turns will be used as the basis for any potential disqualifications. All DPL rules supersede.

Schedule:	Thursday, October 21, 2010
Location:	Alfred J. Loos Natatorium (8 lanes with elevated seating for spectators). 3900 Spring Valley Roadbetween Midway and Marsh.
Eligibility:	A swimmer must be enrolled as a full-time student at a DPL member school . All swimmers must be enrolled in the 5^{th} , 6^{th} , 7^{th} , or 8^{th} grades. One or more swimmers will constitute a team for any given school; therefore schools are not allowed to combine to form teams .
Divisions :	Events will be divided by Junior Varsity ($5^{th} / 6^{th}$) and Varsity ($7^{th} / 8^{th}$). Swimmers in the 5^{th} & 6^{th} grades may swim varsity events but not both JV and varsity in the same meet.
Uniforms:	Swimmers do not have to dress uniformly, but should wear proper swim attire.

	ners may swim in a maximum of four (4) events, of which no more than three (3) may be individual events. may enter no more than three swimmers per event and no more than two relays per event; EXCEPT JV TEAMS WILL BE ALLOWED 3 ADDITIONAL ND SWIMMERS IN THE 50 FREE. Teams entering two relays in a given event should designate them as "A" and "B". Only the "A" relay will count for scoring.
Once the entries have been submitted to the DPL office, only scratches will be excepted.	
Scoring: Relays	Individual Events will score for the first 6 places as follows: 10-8-6-4-2-1 and will score double: 20-16-12-8-4-2.
Coaches:	Due to limited space, each school will be limited to a maximum of two (2) coaches on the deck.
Timers:	Each school will be responsible for providing a sufficient number of timers during the meet. Those numbers will be determined once the final athlete count is in.
Heating: A=Yea	Please use a lettering system as follows to help insure better heating of swimmers. ar Round Swimmer B=Seasonal Swimmer (Summer Only) C=Novice Swimmer
Rosters:	 Each team must submit a roster via fax to the DPL office no later than 7 days prior to the meet. All rosters will be considered complete when they have the following: School Name Swimmer's Name, Grade Level, School Attended A.D.'s Signature Copies of each team's roster will be kept on file at the league office.
Entries:	Entry forms are due no later than 5pm on Wednesday, October 12th. These must be faxed (972.404.0379) or e-mailed to the DPL office. Late entries or changes will not be excepted.
